Note: From 1 November 2021, to comply with choice of fund rules, if a Choice of Fund form is not provided, your employer may need to request 'stapled super fund' details from the ATO. A stapled fund is an existing super account which is linked, or 'stapled' to an individual employee so it follows you as you change jobs. In certain circumstances your employer may not be required to accept your Choice of Fund form. The ATO will notify you if your employer makes a stapled fund request.
